- ► The Exercise and Sport Studies, Honours Program Apply in 3rd year

- Deferred Exam extenuating circumstances only

 - After Oct 2 no tuition credit
 - NOV 15 Last day to drop any T1 class
 - ► CANNOT DROP CLASSES AFTER THIS DATE
